The purpose of these conditions is to apply consistent operating standards for access and utilisation of wharf areas adjacent to the licensed area and the berth.

Activities not listed in these Berthing Conditions are considered Not Permitted unless written permission is granted by City of Melbourne, the Licensor. Any breach by the Licensee of the conditions outlined herein will be considered a breach of the Licence.
