DODDS STREET LINEAR PARK

Project update, April 2023

City of Melbourne's works on the Dodds Street Linear Park are progressing well. The project is on track and we're excited to be one step closer to improving this under-explored part of the city.

We're now moving on to stage two works, towards the Southbank Boulevard end of the street. Works during this stage include:

- demolition
- excavation
- pipe laying
- installation of concrete base for paving
- bluestone paving.

Once the project is complete, this section will operate as a shared zone and enable the arts precinct businesses to continue creating the world-class artistic and cultural offerings our city is known for.

Two temporary crossing points are now available for pedestrians, one is at University of Melbourne's linear park (pictured below) and one is at the service laneway.

Traffic changes

Dodds Street is closed to public vehicles between Southbank Boulevard and Grant Street until the end of July 2023. Delivery vehicles exiting the service laneway must turn right towards Grant Street.

Pedestrian access

Pedestrian access to all properties in Dodds Street will be maintained throughout the works. Bike and scooter riders must dismount to ensure Dodds Street remains safe for everyone.
