• have been in Naarm for many years





• look after the land, water and sky.




This book is about our **Inclusive Melbourne** plan.

diverse groups


- can get jobs with us

• going to places you want to go.


# 3. Everyone can be part of the community

- take action to make the community better.


#### We want everyone to be able to
