


Environmental Upgrade Finance





- Landscaping soil moisture sensors

Victorian Energy Efficiency Target (VEET)

State government called Energy Saver Incentive Program

Objective

- To reduce greenhouse gas emissions by encouraging the purchase and installation of energy efficient products
- Energy providers subsidise efficiency works
- Purchase certificates representing tonnes of CO₂-e migitated

Benefits

Provides direct subsidies for energy efficiency activities



Victorian Energy Efficiency Target (VEET)

~ 28 Prescribed Activities and more are planned.

Prescribed Activities include:

Gas to gas boosted solar hot water

Gas ductwork replacement

Underfloor insulation

Window replacement

Weather sealing

Standby power controllers
