JJ HOLLAND PARK PLAY SPACE RENEWAL

Project update

February 2021

The City of Melbourne will commence works this week to upgrade the JJ Holland Park Playground and create new play spaces for children to enjoy. After gathering community feedback through two phases of engagement, a final concept plan has been developed for the playground which is attached. The renewed play space design is made up of a series of connected zones, providing a range of play opportunities. Key features will include:

- a toddler play space, junior play space and bridged play space, including a spacenet, monkey bars and flying fox
- an active play space, including the existing basketball half-court
- a BBQ zone and meeting area.

Play opportunities during construction

This project was postponed in 2020 in order to allow children to enjoy the existing playground during the summer school holiday period.

A number of playgrounds are available within walking distance while works are underway in 2021. Please refer to the below map.

Construction program

Works will commence on 1 February and be completed in June 2021. Construction of the playground will occur in two stages:

February to April

Removal of existing equipment and construction of paths and footings, installation of irrigation, electrical works for the new BBQ and general landscaping.

May to June


Installation of new equipment and opening of new playground.
