Construction of the City of Melbourne's new play space at JJ Holland Park is on track to be completed by the middle of June.

Work update

Since work commenced in February, we have removed the existing equipment, installed new specialised play equipment, constructed new paths, installed furniture, a silent basketball backboard, irrigation and electrical services for the new BBQ. We have also done extensive planting and general landscaping.

Final touches are now being made to the new play equipment which includes three new play spaces for diverse play, and new features such as a play bridge, space-net, monkey bars and flying fox. The existing basketball half-court has also been integrated into the space.

Opening

Children will be able to enjoy the new play space from **the week commencing 14 June**. The new BBQ, seating and picnic facilities can also be used from this time.

The only remaining works will be the planting of trees around the play space which will occur in the same week as the opening. This is in line with the City of Melbourne's tree planting program.

We thank you for your patience during construction and hope the local community enjoys using the renewed play space at JJ Holland Park for many years to come.
