E-Tendering Solution

Purpose and background

- 1. The purpose of this report is to propose to enter into a contract for the provision of an E-Tendering Solution for a period of five years.
- 2. The E-tendering Solution is an electronic tender box which allows potential suppliers to download tendering documentation and upload their submissions.
- 3. The current contract for the provision of an electronic tender box expires on 23 September 2014.
- 4. A Registration of Interest (ROI) was undertaken to provide an open and competitive process which was followed by a Request for Quotation.
- 5. The ROI was advertised in 'The Age' newspaper on Saturday 24 May 2014 and closed on Monday 2 June 2014.
- 6. The weightings of the evaluation criteria as declared in the ROI were Cost (60 per cent), Features of the Proposed Solution and Implementation (30 per cent), Local content, Training, Support and Maintenance (10 per cent).

Key issues

- 7. During the evaluation process demonstrations were provided by the shortlisted organisations to better understand the features of their proposed solution.
- 8. The features of the proposed solution as well as customer service, local content, ongoing support and maintenance were considered in the decision making process.
- 9. Four organisations were non-conforming.
- 10. Fairfax Digital Australia/New Zealand Pty Ltd is being recommended.
- 11. The cost to Council for the E-Tendering Solution is \$12,500 (ex GST) over a period of five years. There will be no charges to suppliers to use the E-Tendering Solution.

Recommendation from management

12. That Council award the contract for the processing of E-Tendering Solution to Fairfax Digital Australia/New Zealand Pty Ltd trading as Tenderlink.com for a term of five years for a contract sum of \$12,500 (ex GST) for the term of the contract and otherwise in accordance with the negotiated terms and conditions of the contract.

- 7. Utilizing an e-tender box will reduce the paper usage significantly. A reduction of approximately 3050 reams of paper per annum can be achieved.
