Allocation of the Discretionary Fund: Second Quarter 2014–15

10 February 2015

Presenter: Martin Cutter, Director City Business

Purpose and background

 The purpose of this report is to advise the Future Melbourne Committee of the projects supported through the allocation of discretionary funding for the second quarter of the 2014–15 financial year in accordance with Future Melbourne Committee requirements.

Key issues

- 2. Total discretionary funding allocated during the second quarter of the 2014–15 financial year was \$129,992. The individual items funded are listed in Attachment 2.
- 3. This funding has been met within an existing 2014–15 budget allocation of \$300,000 held within the City Business Division comprising:
 - 3.1. \$200,000 for Council support for various charitable, community and other eligible organisations and activities, via cash sponsorships (year to date allocation \$192,832, unexpended funds \$7,168).
 - 3.2. \$70,000 for Council support of the same via use of the Melbourne Town Hall venue (year to date allocation \$47,774, unexpended funds \$22,226).
 - 3.3. \$30,000 for Council support of the same via purchase of table sponsorships (year to date allocation \$20,342, unexpended funds \$9,658).
- 4. As at the end of the second quarter, unexpended funds in the total \$300,000 budget for 2014–15 were \$39,052.
- 5. The total value of discretionary in-kind waivers approved for the second quarter was \$20,260. Details are listed in Attachment 2.

Recommendation from management

6. That the Future Melbourne Committee receives the report on the allocation of discretionary funds for the second quarter of the 2014–15 financial year.

- 5. The City of Melbourne has a number of formal funding programs that have been established to meet Council policy objectives within the Council Plan. Current grants programs include support for arts and culture, events, small business and export, sport and recreation and community services.
- 6. Discretionary funds are allocated from time to time to requests made outside of the normal funding program planning and funding cycles, subject to meeting the criteria established via Future Melbourne Committee resolution on 9 July 2013. This criteria states that requests for discretionary funding will only be considered if:
 - 6.1. They are received with a lead time of greater than 90 days to the date of the event (with the exception of table sponsorships).
 - 6.2. They would be ineligible for funding from existing programs.

7. There is no significant impact on environmental sustainability arising from or related to the recommendation in this report.
