 - 1.2 The height of the proposal is excessive and is contrary to the objective of Clause 55.03-2 of the Melbourne Planning Scheme.
 - 1.3 The demolition of the heritage building is inappropriate and is contrary the objectives of Clause 22.05 and 43.01 of the Melbourne Planning Scheme.

1. That the Future Melbourne Committee resolves to issue a Notice of Decision to Grant a Permit in accordance with the conditions set out in the delegate report (refer Attachment 4 of the report from management) with conditions 1(b) and 1(c) amended as follows:

- 1.1 Condition 1b) The proposed building to be set back a minimum of 2.5 metres from the Elizabeth Street property boundary at level 1 and four metres for each floor above level 1 generally in accordance with the sketch plans prepared by Crone Partners dated and received on 10 February 2015.
- 1.2 Condition 1c) The roof plant to be set back a minimum of seven metres from the Elizabeth Street property boundary and a minimum of three metres and six metres respectively from the southern property boundary where this is opposite the existing light well of 222-230 Victoria Street, Melbourne. This should be generally in accordance with the sketch plans prepared by Crone Partners dated and received on 10 February 2015, but with the 3 metre setback continuing the full length of the southern boundary wall.

 - 1.1. Estimates the proportion of total Land Tax, Fire Services Levy and Congestion Tax revenue collected by the State which comes from landowners in the City of Melbourne, including by directly requesting the information from the State Revenue Office.
 - 1.2. Assesses what proportion of City of Melbourne's residential and non-residential rate payers are liable for land tax.
 - 1.3. Summarises the impact of the 2014 site value valuations in the City of Melbourne on state government land tax revenue.
 - 1.4. Compares historical rate in the dollar levels of land tax against City of Melbourne rates over the past 25 years.
 - 1.5. Provides analysis of the tax rates used by the state in the collection of the fire Services levy, Land Tax and Congestion Tax and compares shifts in annual yields to that achieved in the City of Melbourne.
 - 1.6. Outlines the revenue split in the four major annualised property holding taxes (land tax, council rates, fire services levy and congestion tax) between residential and non-residential property owners in the City of Melbourne.
