Participation in Australian Local Government Association National General Assembly, Canberra, 17 to 20 June 2018

Purpose and background

- 1. The purpose of this report is to provide for City of Melbourne participation in the Australian Local Government Association's (ALGA) National General Assembly (NGA) to be held in Canberra between 17 and 20 June 2018.
- 2. The ALGA NGA provides a forum for local government to discuss and advance issues of national significance to local government.

Key issues

- 3. The 2018 NGA theme is *Australia's future: Make it local* and reflects not just the wide scope and importance of local government, but its ability to influence and affect fundamental change and improvement at the community level. Within the main theme, the NGA program offers a number of panel sessions under the following banners.
 - 3.1. Changing political culture.
 - 3.2. Balancing innovation and the public interest.
 - 3.3. Population and the policy imperative.
 - 3.4. Building tomorrow's communities: Liveability.
 - 3.5. How to create resilient local communities.
- 4. Councillors have given consideration to the appropriate level of participation in the NGA and nominated Councillors Beverley Pinder and Rohan Leppert to represent City of Melbourne.
- 5. The cost associated with participation in the NGA is estimated at \$3415 per Councillor. This includes airfare, accommodation for three nights, registration and incidental costs.

Recommendation from management

6. That Council approves participation by Councillors Beverley Pinder and Rohan Leppert in the Australian Local Government Association's National General Assembly in Canberra between 17 and 20 June 2018 at an estimated cost of \$3415 per Councillor.
