## **Application dates**

Applications open: 21 August 2023 Applications close: 11.59pm, 1 October 2023 Notification to applicants: November 2023

### **Grant categories**

The following grants are available for activities taking place in 2024.

- up to \$20,000 for the creation and presentation of projects that are presented to the public, or
- up to \$5,000 for a creative development (a public presentation is optional).

# Who can apply?

Applications are open to Aboriginal artists and arts organisations who plan to develop or present work in 2024.

The City of Melbourne welcomes grant applications from Deaf and Disabled artists.

Only one application can be submitted.

# Are you eligible?

Not all types of projects are eligible for funding. Contact the <u>City of Melbourne Arts Grants</u> team to find out if your project is eligible for funding.

Make sure your public presentation takes place within the City of Melbourne <u>Council</u> <u>boundaries<sup>1</sup></u>

Note: There are extra eligibility requirements for creative developments and online projects.

- 3. Apply via the SmartyGrants online application form (log in or create an account).
- 4. Contact the Arts Grants team with any queries.
- 5. Allow plenty of time to plan, gather support material and to draft your application.
- 6. Complete and submit your online application by 11.59pm on 1 October.

Applicants should do their best to make their project accessible.

Access support is available for Deaf and Disabled people when applying.

Deaf and Disabled, neurodiverse and chronically ill artists can apply for an extra \$2,000 to cover access costs.
