# Make a bird puppet to star in your show


## Instructions

- Draw the bird patterns onto a piece of paper, making sure that they are a mirror image of each other.
- Cut out each pattern.
- Stick a paddle pop stick or wooden chopstick onto one side with sticky tape.
- Fold down the wings.
- Stick the two sides together, with the wings folded outwards.
- Decorate with buttons, paint, crayons, markers, bits of coloured paper, or whatever you can find!

What is your bird's name? Where is the bird going? And Why? What is the bird's story?

Move your puppet up and down to watch it flap its wings!






#### You will need

- Coloured paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- A paddle pop stick or a wooden chopstick
- Buttons, crayons, markers or paint for decoration
