BRENS PAVILION REDEVELOPMENT

Project update

May 2022

City of Melbourne has commenced works to redevelop Brens Pavilion located in Royal Park between Melbourne Zoo and Royal Parade.

Demolition and ground works are underway to prepare the site for the construction of the frame and roof.

Pavilions in Royal Park

Brens Pavilion is being developed by City of Melbourne in partnership with the Victorian Government. It will include spaces for social activities and food preparation, eight gender neutral change rooms and two change rooms for umpires.

This means more teams and community groups will be able to use the new facilities when the pavilion reopens, aligning with Council's major initiative to increase and upgrade accessible, inclusive spaces for women in City of Melbourne sports facilities.

This project is one of three pavilions in Royal Park to be upgraded by City of Melbourne. The Western Pavilion upgrade will be completed in May 2022, while Ryder Pavilion is currently in design.
