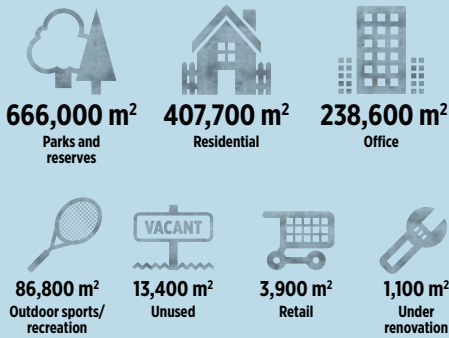


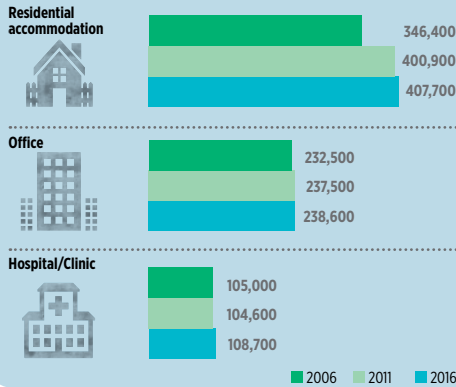
# EAST MELBOURNE CLUE 2016 REPORT

East Melbourne is home to many important landmarks including Parliament House, St Patrick's Cathedral and the Melbourne Cricket Ground. Though the area has a reputation as being traditional and unchanging in its built form and character, there is evidence of change and growth over time. Note that the shift of the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre from East Melbourne to the new Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre in Parkville occurred after the completion of the 2016 data collection for East Melbourne, and so is not reflected in this dataset.

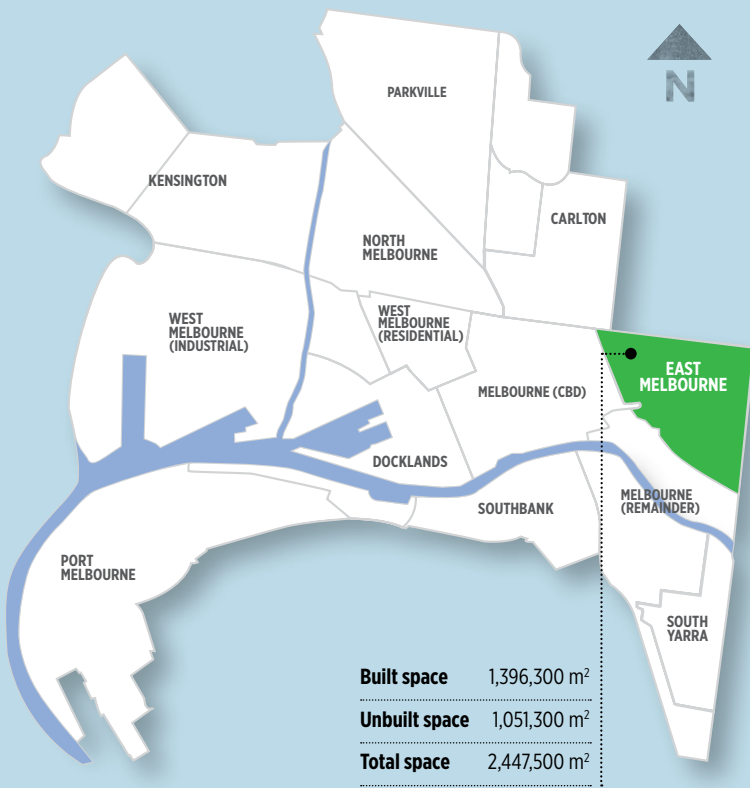
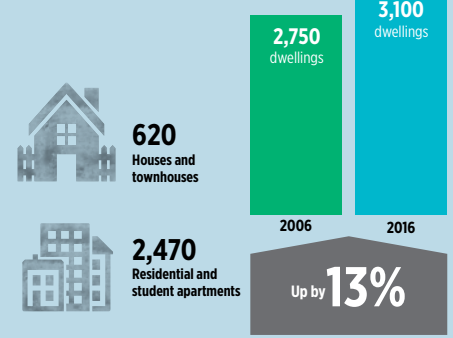

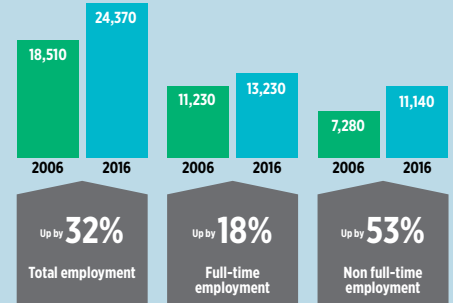
## TOP 3 BUILT SPACE USES (m<sup>2</sup>)



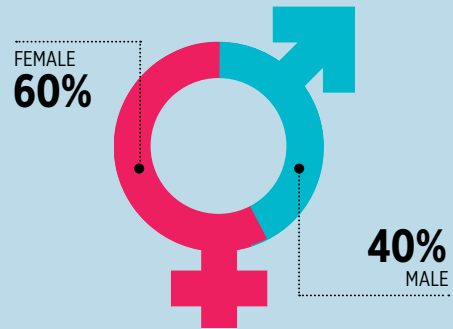

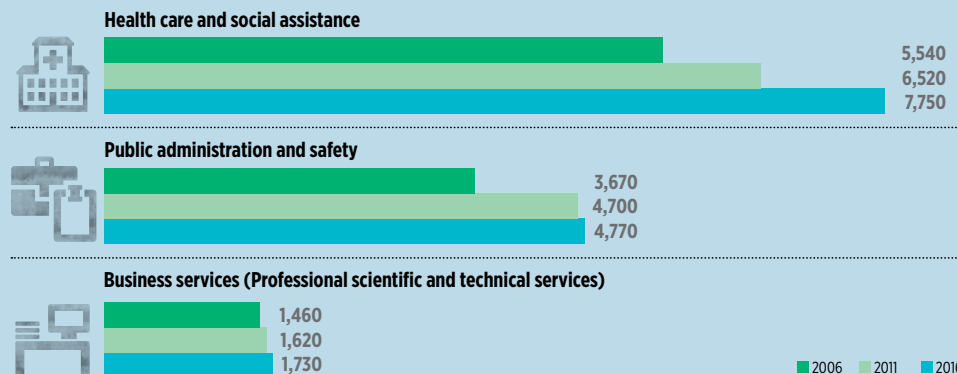
## EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE (NUMBER OF JOBS)
