CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN 1

October 2018

Situated in North Melbourne, Lady Huntingfield Children's Centre was closed this year to undergo redevelopment works, and will reopen in 2020 to become an integrated child and family centre.

The redevelopment works will ensure the centre continues to serve the growing and diverse needs of the local community. The design will incorporate environmental and sustainable features as well as offering 106 child care places.

Construction has now commenced and the new centre will open in 2020.

Upcoming Works



Site Establishment Works

- Site hoarding to the east, west and rear title boundary adjoining Plane Tree Way.
- Establishment of site sheds on the existing footpath along Haines Street.
- Establishment of a temporary pedestrian pathway on Haines Street.
- Establishment of traffic signs and controllers to manage diverted pedestrians, cyclists and movement of construction vehicles in and out of the site.
- Establishment of tree protection zones for the 12 remaining trees.



Demolition

- Demolition of the existing childcare centre
- Removal of nine existing trees
- Bulk excavation works
- Crane installation



In-Ground Works

- Establishment of in-ground works
- Installation of Ground Heat Exchangers
