

# LONSDALE STREET GREEK PRECINCT UPGRADE

## Project completion

August 2022

City of Melbourne's upgrade to the historical Lonsdale Street Greek Precinct is now complete.

The improvements made between Tattersalls Lane and Russell Street provide a spacious area for the community to dine and enjoy the local restaurants.

The dining facilities are surrounded by planter boxes filled with lush rosemary. The tree bases have been replaced, giving the trees better air flow and room to grow leading into the warmer months.

The works included:

- removing five existing cafe shelters
- repairing broken bluestone pavers
- reinstating Hellenic Greek edge stone pavers
- installing new stainless steel planter boxes with irrigation systems and lush greenery
- installing permeable paving systems around tree bases.
