Provide anecdotal evidence or documentation of results
Outline how the organisation/project has been received by the community
Describe if the organisation/project has achieved outcomes beyond what was expected
Outline the obstacles that were encountered or any issues faced in the day-to-day running of the organisation/project.
• Detail the steps you have taken to overcome these challenges, and any plans you have in place to avoid these occurring in the future.
• Outline long-term planning, succession planning and the vision for the future.
