 - 1.2. an instrument of sub-delegation 2019-65 dated 3 December 2019
 - 1.3. all other powers held by or delegated to me,
 and having taken into account the obligations of the Council pursuant to the
 Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities

THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:

- 2. Subject to compliance with the Condition of Exemption detailed in the prescription, all persons are exempted throughout the whole year from the requirement to have a permit under clauses 4.2, 4.9, 5.1, 5.3, 5.4, 5.5, 5.7 and 5.10 of the Local Law, where the activity for which a permit would otherwise have been required but for this prescription:
 - is carried out with the prior written approval of Dexus Wholesale
 Management Limited (Land Owner); and
 - 2.2. occurs within that part of the municipality of the Council shown hatched and within the bold lines on Attachment 1.

Condition of Exemption

A person carrying on an activity without a permit in reliance on this prescription must at all times carry the prior written approval of the Land Owner and must produce such approval, immediately on request by an Authorised Officer of the Council.
