

**MELBOURNE CITY COUNCIL ('Council')**

**PRESCRIPTION UNDER THE ACTIVITIES LOCAL LAW 2019 ('Local Law')**

1. In exercise of:
  - 1.1. an instrument of delegation from the Council (register number 360) authorised by a resolution of the Council passed on 29 March 2005
  - 1.2. an instrument of sub-delegation 2019-30 dated 5 May 2019
  - 1.3. all other powers held by or delegated to me,and having taken into account the obligations of the Council pursuant to the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities.

**THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:**

2. Subject to compliance with the Condition of Exemption detailed in this prescription, all persons are exempted throughout the whole of each year from the requirement to have a *permit* under clause, 5.3 of the Local Law, where the activity for which a *permit* would otherwise have been required but for this prescription:
  - 2.1. is carried out within the Docklands Area as defined in the *Docklands Act 1991*; and
  - 2.2. is carried out in accordance with a permit or licence issued by the Victorian Urban Development Authority ("VicUrban") on or before 30 June 2007 under the *Public Amenity Local Law 1999* as existed prior to 1 July 2007.

**Condition of Exemption**

A person carrying on an activity without a permit in reliance on this prescription must at all times carry the permit or licence issued by VicUrban and must produce the same, immediately on request by an *Authorised Officer* of the Council.
