PRESCRIPTION UNDER THE ACTIVITIES LOCAL LAW 2019 ('Local Law')

- 1. In exercise of:
 - 1.1.an instrument of delegation from the Council (Register no CCL-2020-1) made pursuant to section 11(1) the Local Government Act 2020 ('the Act')
 - 1.2. an instrument of sub-delegation 2020 65 dated 3 December 2020
 - 1.3. the power given to the Council by clause 1.10 of Part 1 of the Local Law
 - 1.4. all other powers held by or delegated to me,
 - and having taken into account the obligations of the Council pursuant to the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities

THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:

- 2. Subject to compliance with the Condition of Exemption detailed below and with the exception of the locations referred to in clause 3, all persons are exempted throughout the whole year from the requirement to have a permit under clauses 4.1, 4.2, 4.9, 5.1, 5.3, 5.4, 5.5, 5.7 and 5.10 of the Local Law, where the location of the activity is the subject of a written lease or licence entered into with the Council.
- 3. Clause 2 does not apply to the following premises:
 - 3.1.25 New Quay Promenade (Marina 25) Docklands retail shop
 - 3.2.35 New Quay Promenade (Marina 29) Docklands café
 - 3.3.45 New Quay Promenade (Marina 45) Docklands retail shop, restaurant
 - 3.4.152 Sturt Street Southbank, Guild Apartment, Suite 3 café

Condition of Exemption

A person carrying on an activity without a permit in reliance on this prescription must produce the lease or licence entered into with the Council, immediately on request by an Authorised Officer of the Council.
