# Munro site: corner of Queen and Therry streets

Construction of the City of Melbourne's largest new community hub and new Queen Victoria Market customer car parking is underway.

Right on the market's doorstep, at the corner of Queen and Therry streets, this will be one of Melbourne's best developments in decades. It delivers substantial public benefit to the growing city north with new community facilities, childcare, affordable housing and event spaces.

Included in the City of Melbourne's new community facilities will be a new 500 space car park for market customers together with complementary retail, pocket park and laneways as well as residential apartments and a hotel. This mixed use project will be a major drawcard for visitors to the market precinct.

As with any significant construction project there will be short-term disruption. We will work closely with Queen Victoria Market Pty Ltd, local businesses and neighbours to reduce the impact of any works and ensure the site is well presented as construction progresses.

The Munro site is a key project in the Queen Victoria Market Precinct Renewal Program. The project is being delivered by developer PDG Corporation.








### **Site location**

# **Key project dates**

Part of the Queen Victoria Market Precinct Renewal Program, developer PDG Corporation with builder Hamilton Marino will deliver the project in key stages:

STAGE	INDICATIVE TIMELINE
Stage 1 – Mercat Cross façade retention and demolition of Therry and Queen Street buildings	approx 4 months#
Stage 2 - Excavation and construction of basement car park	approx 18 months#
Stage 3 - Construction of City of Melbourne community hub	approx 6 months#
<b>Stage 4</b> - Construction of City of Melbourne affordable housing and fit out of community hub	approx 5 months#
Stage 5 - Construction of hotel and QVM Residences	Subject to completion of Stages 1 - 4

### What to expect

With any construction project of this scale there will be short-term disruption as well as changes to the way you access the area.

The standard hours of work will be from 7am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday, except Wednesday when works will finish at 4.30pm, and Saturday 7am to 3.30pm.

For works outside of these periods, builder Hamilton Marino will apply for appropriate permits and provide notice to residents, businesses and the market.

Residents and businesses in close proximity to the work area may experience some inconvenience.

A small number of parking spaces on Therry and Queen streets will be removed and there will be changed traffic conditions and pedestrian access around the site during construction. Traffic management will be closely managed throughout construction.

### What's happening in September/October



### Early works

Service relocations for power, gas and water are underway as the construction zone is established. The heritage façade of the Mercat Hotel will be secured for retention works.



#### Vehicle access

While early works are underway there may be traffic changes in Queen and Therry streets and an increase in truck movements. A small number of parking spaces will be removed near the corner of Queen and Therry streets while the Mercat facade is secured. Please be patient and follow the signs and directions of traffic controllers.



#### Pedestrians

There will be changes to pedestrian access around the site for the duration of construction works as well as increased traffic movements. Pedestrians are encouraged to follow designated footpaths and be mindful when crossing roads in and around the site.
