

Work to repair, conserve and restore the market's historic open-air sheds is underway.

We're investing more than \$25 million to restore the market's historic sheds, securing them as the unique backdrop of the market experience.

The on-site restoration works, including structural upgrades and installation of services, are authorised under Heritage Victoria Permit Number P31886.

Stage 1 work area

Stage 1 restoration works include Sheds J to M (see map below highlighting works area) with works occurring Monday to Saturday. When the Victorian Government lifts restrictions on non-food market stalls, the upper market will operate across Sheds A to F to enable these important restoration works to continue.



Noise


