CONSTRUCTION BULLETIN 4

Major tram works

In September, major tram works will begin as part of the Transforming Southbank Boulevard project.

A new central island tram stop will be built on the corner of Sturt Street and Southbank Boulevard, along with a section of green track.

This new central island tram stop will replace the two existing single direction stops, and will service the Arts Precinct, as well as the new public parks on Southbank Boulevard. The stop will be accessible with signalised crossings at both ends.

How will this affect you?

What would normally take weeks to build will be packed into nine days to minimise disruption to both trams and the community.

During this period there will be road closures, and works will take place outside of the usual construction working hours, including night works.

Road closures

15-22 September

From 15-22 September a section of Sturt Street will be closed to vehicle traffic between the Melbourne Recital Centre and Kavanagh Street to enable footpath and kerb realignment works to be undertaken. Trams will operate during this period.

22-30 September


From 22-30 September the area illustrated in red will be closed to all traffic, including trams, while major tram works are undertaken.

- ٠ construction of tram pole footings and installation of tram poles
- demolition of the existing tram tracks • between St Kilda Road and Sturt Street
- installation of new tram tracks •
- construction of a new central island • tram stop and overhead wiring.





Tram Diversions

The Route 1 tram will be diverted between Sturt Street and Swanston Street from 22 - 30 September. The last tram to operate will be the final service on Friday 21 September.

The Route 1 Tram will not run between stop 20 at Kings Way, and Stop 8 at Melbourne Central during construction. Tram replacement bus services will operate between Sturt Street and St Kilda Road.

MAJOR TRAM WORKS PERIOD


Full road closure, demolition of existing tram infrastructure, construction and recommissioning of new tram line and tram stop on Sturt Street.
