Post travel report by Lord Mayor, Robert Doyle: Travel to Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) 2015 CEO Summit, Manila, November 2015

2 February 2016

## Purpose and background

- 1. The purpose of this report is to advise the Future Melbourne Committee on the Lord Mayor's attendance at the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) 2015 CEO Summit held in Manila between 15 and 20 November 2015.
- 2. The APEC 2015 CEO Summit covered the costs associated with the Lord Mayor's airfare and accommodation. City of Melbourne covered incidental expenditure totalling \$417.18 as detailed in this report.

## **Key issues**

- 3. On 22 September 2015, the APEC 2015 CEO Chairman wrote to the Lord Mayor inviting him to be a keynote speaker on a panel discussion on the topic "What will the future of the city look like?"
- 4. The Lord Mayor was subsequently invited to address the media at the launch of PriceWaterhouseCooper's (PWC's) *Building Better Cities Report*.
- 5. On 16 November 2015, the Lord Mayor attended:
  - 5.1 The Summit opening presented by the Philippines President Benigno Aquino III and APEC 2015 CEO Summit Chairman Tony Tan Caktiong.
  - 5.2 The panel discussion on the new global context, *'Navigating Uncertainty'*, led by the President of Chile, Michelle Bachelet.
  - 5.3 An insight session from David Plouffe, Chief Adviser and Member of the Board of Directors of Uber. Mr Plouffe is also a renowned political strategist who managed President of the United States Barack Obama's 2008 presidential campaign.
  - 5.4 The panel discussion on innovation and entrepreneurship, *'The Next Frontier'*, led by Colombian President Juan Manual Santos.
  - 5.5 The Philippines welcomes APEC evening networking event.
- 6. On 17 November 2015, the Lord Mayor:
  - 6.1 Participated in a live ten minute interview from the summit with business reporter Cathy Yang for local news channel ANC's *Market Edge* program regarding the importance of cities.
  - 6.2 Was the keynote speaker at the panel discussion on the importance of cities, 'What will the future of the city look like?' The Lord Mayor was joined on the panel by the CEO of Deutsche Post DHL Group Frank Appel, the CEO of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce Perrin Beatty and the Chairman and CEO of the Ayala Corporation Jaime Augusto Zobel de Ayala. The session was moderated by Chairman of the Asia Inc Forum Timothy Ong and the Lord Mayor responded to questions from the audience following the discussion. The Lord Mayor was the only local government representative to speak at the Summit and his address was extremely well received by the high-level delegation present.
  - 6.3 Presented and responded to questions from media at the launch of PriceWaterhouseCooper's Building Better Cities Report. Joining him at the media briefing were PWC Vice Chairman Robert Gittings and APEC Business Advisory Council (ABAC) Co-Chairman Guillermo Luz. There were journalists and camera crew from ten media outlets present.

- 6.4 Immediately following the media briefing, the Lord Mayor conducted an interview with Russian news agency, *Sputnik*.
- 6.5 Attended the reception for APEC CEO Summit delegates at Ayala Triangle Garden.
- 7. On 18 November 2015, the Lord Mayor attended:
  - 7.1 An insight session from Jack Ma, Executive Chairman of the Alibaba Group;
  - 7.2 The panel discussion on growth, 'Securing growth in a volatile world: what is to be done?', led by H.E. Vice President Jusuf Kalla, Indonesia, H.E. President Enrique Peña Nieto, Mexico and H.E. President Ollanta Humala, Peru. The session was moderated by Richard Quest, International Business Correspondent, CNN.
  - 7.3 A keynote address led by the President of the United States of America, Barack Obama. This was followed by a Q and A session with Jack Ma and Filipina engineer Aisa Mijeno, who invented lamps powered by saline solution, led by the President of the United States of America.
  - 7.4 A keynote address by the President of China Xi Jinping.
  - 7.5 A conversation session with the Prime Minister of Russia Dmitry Medvedev.
- 8. The Lord Mayor's attendance and media interviews resulted in numerous media reports around the world. These are included at attachment 2. Social media was also well utilised. The Lord Mayor tweeted six times from the Summit and the APEC CEO Summit and media and attendees sent tweets about the Lord Mayor's address and media conference.

### Recommendation

9. That the Future Melbourne Committee notes the report by the Lord Mayor on travel to Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) 2015 CEO Summit held in Manila between 15 and 20 November 2015.

- 6. By showcasing Melbourne's achievements to international governments, international media, multinational corporates and other high-level stakeholders, Melbourne's reputation and global positioning will be further enhanced.

### **Environmental sustainability**

7. The carbon emissions resulting from air travel were offset with the purchase of credits.
