# Collins Street, Melbourne Proposed platform tram stops extending across Gurners Lane

## Purpose and background

- 1. Council at its meeting on 28 October 2014 resolved to defer a report on the partial road closure of Gurners Lane due to the construction of platform tram stops across this laneway in Collins Street.
- 2. Council resolved to request that management provide Council with a report on further consultation to be undertaken by management and Yarra Trams with businesses affected by the proposed tram stop in Collins Street, between William and Market Streets, and the associated partial road closure of Gurners Lane.

### **Key issues**

- 3. Yarra Trams has advised that they will not be undertaking public consultation on this matter until December 2014 (see email from Yarra Trams provided as Attachment 2).
- 4. Yarra Trams has advised that it will be arranging two public forums in Collins Street in December 2014 to enable businesses and other stakeholders to examine and discuss the implications of the proposed tram stop and the partial closure of Gurners Lane. Brochures outlining the project and inviting people to attend these forums will be distributed to Collins Street businesses and properties located between Queen Street and King Street. Yarra Trams will also be door knocking businesses along this section of Collins Street and offering one-on-one meetings with business managers.

#### **Recommendation from management**

5. That Council further defer the matter of the partial road closure of Gurners Lane to the February 2015 Council meeting.
