Proposed travel by Councillor Richard Foster, Washington D.C. and New York, USA, 29 June to 8 July 2015

Purpose and background

1. The purpose of this report is to seek Committee approval for Councillor Richard Foster to hold Council business related meetings with government officers in Washington D.C. and New York whilst on private travel between 29 June and 8 July 2015.

Key issues

- 2. Councillor Foster proposes to hold meetings with government officers to gain an insight into the strategies and programs employed by large cities aimed at dealing with homelessness and city safety.
- 3. While in New York a number of relevant urban design interventions will be visited and where possible meetings arranged to enable Councillor Foster to gain a better understanding of how the city is addressing these important opportunities.
- 4. The costs associated with travel by Councillor Foster will be privately funded. Assistance by Council officers will be provided in arranging meetings with relevant officers.

Recommendation

- 5. That the Future Melbourne Committee:
 - 5.1. approves the proposal by Councillor Foster to hold meetings with government officers in Washington D.C. and New York between 29 June and 8 July 2015
 - 5.2. notes that Councillor Foster will prepare a report to the Future Melbourne Committee or Council within 60 days of return from travel.
