Purpose and background

1. The purpose of this report is to inform Council of the financial performance of the 2016–17 Council works program at the end of the second quarter. It also outlines the progress of Council's major projects.

Key issues

- 2. The value of work completed at the end of the second quarter for 2016–17 financial years was \$38.32 million compared to the accumulated Year to Date budget value of \$44.20 million. In summary, the Capital Works program is 87 per cent delivered against planned at the end of the quarter two.
- 3. A detailed report is provided in Attachment 2 of this report.

 - 5.6 enabling sustainable transport (such as Bicycle Improvement Program)

2016–17 Council Works Program Second Quarter Report

1. Overview

The cumulative value of work at the end of the second quarter for 2016–17 financial years was \$38.32 million compared to the accumulated Year to Date budget value of \$44.20 million.

2.1 Financial Analysis

Maintenance

The maintenance program achieved \$4.42 million compared to budgeted value of \$4.72 million which represents 94% delivery against plan to date.

Capital Works

The new works program achieved \$14.24 million compared to budgeted value of \$14.94 million which represents 95% delivery against plan to date.

The renewal works program achieved \$19.66 million compared to budgeted value of \$24.53 million which represents 80% delivery against plan to date.

Capital Works is 13% behind budget on a total program year to date budget of \$39.5 million. The \$5.6 million behind budget is comprised of \$5.9 million ahead of planned and \$11.5 million delays.

Total Council Works

In total, the Council Works program has delivered 87% against year to date budget value for the second guarter of the 2016–17 financial year.

^{**} Variance of \$4.8 million includes delays to flood mitigation, drains renewal, kerb & channel renewal and parks renewal.

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Details of major Capital Works variances this quarter are as follows:

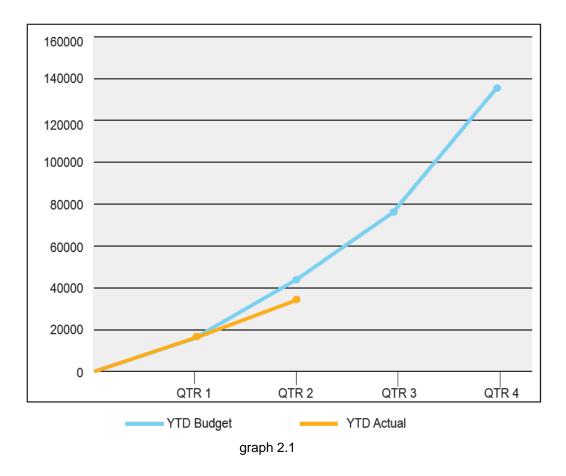
- Royal & Princes Park project and Living Victoria Fund projects spent \$756,094 more than planned in this quarter due to works being completed earlier than expected. Overall budgets remain on track.
- Queen Victoria Market Precinct Renewal Project (QVMPR) spent \$1.924 million less than planned due to revised scope and favourable expenditure against budget
- Flood Mitigation Renewal Works spent \$1.335 million less than planned this quarter due to delays from design scope changes and impact of inclement weather in quarter one.
- Drains, Roadway and Kerb/Channel renewal works spent \$2.084 million less than planned due to works delays however plans in place to accelerate future works to complete as per budget by end guarter four.
- Property Services Corporate Renewal Works spent \$563,000 more than planned due to completion of works earlier than expected. Property Services Community Renewal works spent \$223,921 more than expected due to unforseen kitchen upgrade costs at Kensington Child Care Centre
- Parks Renewal Works program remains behind schedule with \$1,528,808 underspend to date. Contracts and works orders are now in place to deliver planned works by end quarter four

Appendix 3 provides a full list of project variance figures and Appendix 4 provides project specific explanations for major variances over \$200,000.

Program adjustments have been included in Appendix 2. The main adjustments for 2016–17 are:

 A proposal to add \$1.1 million from Clean Energy Finance Corporation funding (CEFC) loan for projects related to the Emissions Reduction Plan.

3. Key Issues

Milestones achieved in the second guarter include:

- University Square The University Square Master Plan was adopted by the Future Melbourne Committee in December 2016. A copy of the endorsed University Square Master Plan was sent to the Melbourne Metro Rail Authority before the Minister approved the Environmental Effects Statement for the Melbourne Metro Tunnel Project.
- Hawke and Adderley Street Open Space Demolition tender was awarded in December 2016.
 Gas was disconnected in January 2016 and demolition works will be completed by April 2017
- Green Your Laneway Pilot Project Stakeholder engagement meetings held late 2016 where different designs were proposed, feedback gathered and designs modified accordingly. Planning for priority laneways (Coromandel Place and Guilford Lane) underway.
- Major Streetscape Improvements and Design Program commenced earlier than scheduled with Spencer Street, Bourke Street, Little Bourke Street and Collins Street projects in progress scheduled for completion quarter three.
- Tree Planting Program 1284 trees have been planted to date as part of annual planting program with an additional 364 trees through developments.

4. Conclusion

This report provides an update of the program including financial analysis for the 2016–17 Council Works Program Second Quarter Report.

1. Queen Victoria Market Precinct Renewal

On Track

Total Project Budget:

Up to \$250 million

2016-17 Budget:

\$9.17 million

Planned completion date:

2021

Scope of work: In October 2013, City of Melbourne announced the largest investment in its history to preserve and renew the Queen Victoria Market (QVM), creating an expanded market precinct. The five year renewal program seeks to retain and restore the market's heritage while moving key market infrastructure and parking below-ground to create more room for market trade and new open space. Importantly, the market will continue to trade right throughout the renewal program with a strong focus on business continuity during construction.



Status:

- Ongoing delivery of Implementation Framework.
- Appointment of the consultant team to advance the design of for the New Market Site pavilion structure.
- Town Planning Application submitted for pavilion structure.
- Working with QVM P/L on the draft Retail Plan which will inform key project scope elements and QVM's business model.
- Ground penetrating radar was undertaken under Sheds A-D, prior to submission of the Precinct Cultural Heritage Management Plan to Aboriginal Victoria.
- Progressing procurement processes in preparation for underground infrastructure, cultural heritage management and conservation management plans.
- Delivery of precinct wide amenity enhancement projects.
- Munro and other planning approvals are dependent upon the approval of Amendment C245. Should the gazettal of C245 be delayed beyond March 2017 this poses a risk to the delivery of community facilities and relocation of the existing 720 space customer car park.

Scope of work: Work in partnership with Melbourne Metropolitan Rail Authority to optimise project benefits for CoM. Planning approval anticipated Dec 2016 / Jan 2017. Early Works contract has commenced and due for completion in Feb 2018. Main contract commences Feb 2018.



Status:

Melbourne Metropolitan Rail Authority (MMRA) has been established by State Government to plan, design and deliver this major city-shaping infrastructure project on behalf of Public Transport Victoria (PTV). City of Melbourne has established a partnership arrangement with MMRA to facilitate delivery and integration of the project.

- Service relocation and geotechnical survey works underway.
- CoM director and two executive / managers meeting with three bid teams to present CoM project requirements and address queries from bidders.
- Ministerial planning approval for the project announced in December 2016 with Planning Scheme Amendment GC45 anticipated to be gazetted in early January 2017.
- Compulsory acquisition of City Square anticipated in February 2017.
- Early works commence in early 2017 in Franklin Street, A'Beckett Street and City Square.



3. Town Hall Precinct (CH1 portion) Redevelopment Proposal

Scope of work: Redevelopment of the Council House 1 precinct to provide Council and commercial accommodation subject to detailed financial and project analysis.

Status:

- A management report submitted to Council on 29 November 2016
 endorsed the administration continuing negotiations with the Metro Tunnel
 project on opportunities at the Over Site Development at CBD South and
 put on hold any decision on future redevelopment of the Town Hall
 Precinct (CH1 portion) until the result of tenders for the Metro Tunnel
 project are known in mid-2017.
- Workshops have been scheduled in January and February 2017 with the
 three shortlisted consortia bidding for the Metro Tunnel and the City of
 Melbourne. The workshops will focus on Council's interest in the Over
 Site Development at CBD South, which includes new office
 accommodation, a new City Library and new visitor centre.



4. Southbank Boulevard Upgrade

Planned completion date: June 2020

Scope of work: The creation of 2.5 hectares of public open space in Melbourne's most densely populated suburb.

Status:

- Phase two community engagement concluded in September 2016.
- Design development and detailed traffic and civil engineering work is underway in preparation for presenting the Southbank Boulevard and Dodds Street Draft Master Plan to Council in March 2017. A key stakeholders meeting will be held with 50 stakeholders to present concepts in February 2017.
- Construction of stage one is slightly delayed to commence in March 2018 to avoid disruption to summer tourism and activities, opening of the new Buxton Gallery and to avoid conflict with Metro Tunnel associated road closures on St Kilda Road.

- The University Square Master Plan was adopted by the Future Melbourne Committee on December 2016. A copy of the endorsed University Square Master Plan was sent to the Melbourne Metro Rail Authority before the Minister approved the Environmental Effects Statement for the Melbourne Tunnel Project.
- Design development, detailed design and tender documentation for stage one works including Leicester Street, The Green and Pelham Street park front has commenced with a view to start construction on September 2017. This will ensure that public open space at University Square remains accessible and active during the construction of the new Parkville Station.

6. Lincoln Square Plaza, Tank and Landscape

Scope of work: To prepare a landscape concept plan for Lincoln Square, following completion of the plaza and flood mitigation/stormwater harvesting tank that sets out a blue print for the future of Lincoln Square. Including potential park expansion, improved pedestrian circulation and a new play space.

- Lincoln Square plaza re-opened December 2016.
- Work on the Storm Water harvesting tanks and diversion pit are almost complete with the Lincoln Square North Road to be reopened the traffic late February 2017.
- The Contract for the power supply to Lincoln Square and Pumping system has been awarded with works due for completion late June 2017.
- Community consultation for the concept plan will commence in February 2017.
- A concept plan for Lincoln Square will be completed by July 2017.

7. South End Elizabeth Street

Scope of work: The southern end of Elizabeth Street streetscape improvement plan (between Flinders Street and Flinders Lane) is being progressed by City Design following targeted stakeholder engagement in 2016. Improvements to the southern end of Elizabeth Street will prioritise pedestrians, improve safety, enhance public open space and the retail interface, as well as ensuring integration with major state government projects at Flinders Street Station and the Metro Rail project. The development of a broader Elizabeth Street Plan, with input from a number of Annual Plan actions that pertain to Elizabeth Street (water management) will be integrated into the Plan and further network analysis and liaison with public transport authorities will inform the plan prior to wider external consultation proposed for April.

Status:

- Project scoping completed to confirm extent of work in Elizabeth Street south-end (Flinders Lane to Flinders Street).
- Concept plans will be prepared and finalised for key stakeholder and public information in April, 2017.
- Design development and tender documentation will be prepared for June, 2017.
- The public tender process will take place in July, 2017 with an anticipated construction date of September, 2017.

3. JH Boyd Redevelopment

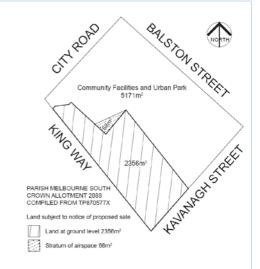

Scope of work: To sell the parcel of land at 229 City Road Southbank for the construction of a residential and commercial development on the land including 40 of the 200 residential apartments being designated affordable housing. To progress the design of a new public park including community endorsement.

Status:

- Contract of sale negotiations drawing to a close with draft agreements being reviewed by solicitors in January.
- Planning for the design of Boyd Park progressing including community updates in February, 2017 and concept designs progressing for phase 2 community engagement (pending completion of the sale)



9. Lady Huntingfield Child Care Centre Upgrade and Hotham Hub

\$9.5 million

2016-17 Budget:

\$2.2 million

Planned completion date:

Feb 2019

Scope of work: The redevelopment of Lady Huntingfield Childcare Centre includes delivering a 106 space childcare centre that incorporates an integrated model including maternal child health, family services and other compatible uses. The temporary relocation of families from Lady Huntingfield to an expanded Hotham Hub Children's Centre is required during 2017–18 to ensure continuity of services during construction.



Status:

Hotham Hub Alterations and additions

- Detailed design and contract documentation now complete
- Expression of interest underway to shortlist construction contractors
- Planning continues for construction commencement in April 2017 with transition of families into the expanded centre in December 2017.

Lady Huntingfield Redevelopment

- Planning continues for construction commencement in January 2018 with transition of families back into the redeveloped centre in early 2019.
- Schematic design underway
- Scope being confirmed as designs are finalised, which will inform budget.

10. Royal Park and Princes Park – Recreation Infrastructure Improvements

- Demolition to commence onsite mid February 2017, due to delay experienced by service authorities in disconnecting the gas service.
 Demolition being managed with urgency, targeting completion by end March 2017.
- Planning permit application has been lodged 4 January 2017.
- Detailed design and documentation is currently in progress and will be completed by mid-April.
- Expression of interest to shortlist contractors to commence mid February.



12. Implementation of Docklands Community and Place Plan

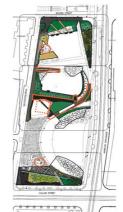

Scope of works: A number of small to medium scale projects to support the implementation of the Docklands Community and Place Plan (DCPP) and Harbour Esplanade.

Status:

- **City Marina:** Survey works complete and concept design underway to develop temporary landscape with shade structure, seating and planting. (*pictured*, *top*)
- Docklands park enhancement works: First stage of renewal works complete. Second stage of documented works include upgrade of landscape, furniture, ramps and planting along with Reed Vessel art work repairs (pictured, middle)
- Docklands South Park: Planning and pre-design investigations commenced to inform park improvements including ecology review, traffic audit, soil/water test and services assessment. Progressing of the replacement of the existing toilet.
- Docklands/Northbank Park: Promenade and crane remediation documentation underway to be completed by end of 2018 (phase one). MoU between the State Government, City of Melbourne and Riverlee is under consideration for remediation of existing sub structure (phase two). A brief for the public park is being established (phase 3) to advance the design process including community engagement. (pictured, bottom)







13. Green Your Laneway Pilot Project

Sep 2017

Scope of work: Introduction of green infrastructure to existing building at various locations at the CBD.

Status:

- Planning complete with four laneways selected from community nominations: Meyers Place, Coromandel Place, Guildford Lane and Katherine Place
- Stakeholder engagement targeted meetings were held where different laneway designs were proposed, feedback gathered and designs modified in early November.
- Concept design of the greening infrastructure for all four laneways was completed in mid-January 2017.
- EOI for the engagement of specialist greening contractors currently being evaluated.
- The fee proposal for the design of civil works associated with the installation of the greening infrastructure is due 8 February 2017
- Efforts prioritised to ensure Coromandel Place and Guilford Lane completion by end June 2017 with Meyers Place and Katherine Place by end Sept 2017.

14. Major Streetscape Improvements and Design (excluding South End Elizabeth Street)

\$4.84 million

Planned completion date:

June 2017

Scope of work: Various CBD footpath upgrades to bluestone paving plus major streetscape upgrade projects comprising Southbank Promenade and NewQuay Docklands.

Status:

- 2016–17 major streetscape program commenced earlier than scheduled with Spencer Street, Bourke Street, Little Bourke Street and Collins Street projects in progress scheduled for completion during Q3.
- Balance of program is allocated to Southbank Promenade upgrade with scheduled commencement during Q4.

15. Tree Planting Program

Budget:

\$1.5 million

Planned completion date:

June 2017

Scope of works: Tree planting program for the municipality

Status:

- A total of 1284 trees have been planted from July 1 to 31 October 2016 as part of the annual planting program.
 An additional 364 trees have been planted through developments. The planting season finished on 31 October 2016 and will resume again on 1 April 2017.
- 17 new species of trees for Melbourne have been introduced this planting season in a range of locations throughout the city.
- Work is now underway to design and plan for tree planting activities in 2017. Community consultation is underway for new tree planting within eleven streetscapes across three precincts - South Yarra, Kensington and East Melbourne. The streets are endorsed for tree planting activity in the Urban Forest Precinct Plans.
- An independent audit of trees planted in 2014, 2015 and 2016 is currently underway and due to be completed in January 2017. This audit will help ensure that recently planted trees are meeting quality standards and that the trees are being maintained properly.

16. Bicycle Improvement Program

Planned completion date:

Scope of works: Various bicycle and motor cycle improvement work throughout municipality.

Status:

All the projects have been scoped and issued for design and construction. Detailed design and consultation for 70%
of the projects have construction is in progress. The detailed design for the balance 30% of the projects are currently
being completed with a small number requiring VicRoads approval prior to construction.

17. Flood Mitigation Works

\$4.59 million Scope of work: Various flood mitigation new and renewal works throughout municipality.

- Renewals including Rankins Road and Munster Terrace drain.
- New works including Clarendon Street and Whiteman Street flooding.

- Reviewed the final drainage investigation report for the Arden Macaulay section of the creek. Met with Melbourne Water to obtain understanding of Melbourne Water's position in relation to recommendations provided in the final drainage investigation report and creek sections external to Arden Macaulay. Progressed development of City of Melbourne position on the drainage investigation report and contribute to external stakeholder engagement process and master plan development for Arden Macaulay.
- Tender documentation for the Whiteman Street Drainage Works finalized. Contract to be awarded mid March and works completed by 30 June 2017
- Clarendon St Pump Station feasibility study completed regarding design of new in ground pump station adjacent to Spencer St bridge. Expected completion of design in April 2017 followed by tender
- Delivery of renewal works ongoing. 13 projects have been identified and issued for design / investigation and construction. Construction complete for upgrade drains in Munster Terrace between Victoria St and Laurens St as well as new drains in Rankins Road. Upgrade drains are complete for Ireland Street, between Dryburgh St and Anderson St. Installation of temporary relief drain in Whiteman St also completed

18. Energy Efficient Street Light Renewal

Scope of work: LED upgrade works to street lighting

Status:

- Cost share arterial road street lighting agreement with VicRoads completed.
- West Melbourne LED street lighting upgrade (1,090 lights) commenced in December 2016 and scheduled for completion by CitiPower by 28 February 2017.
- Kensington, Fishermans Bend, Port Melbourne, Parkville street lights (1,257) scheduled for upgrade to LED by CitiPower in March 2017.
