Purpose and background

1. The purpose of this report is to update the authorisations from Council to staff in regards to the *Planning* and *Environment Act 1987* (the Act).

Key issues

- 2. Most delegations and authorisations to a member of staff are made by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) under delegation.
- 3. Whilst the Act was amended in 2017 to allow the CEO to sub delegate the Council's powers, discretions or functions to members of staff, it still prohibits the delegation by Council of the power to appoint authorised officers under it.
- 4. One new staff member has commenced with the Planning Enforcement team and requires authorisation to undertake the duties of an authorised officer under the Act.

Recommendation from management

5. That Council appoints Jayme Thompson as an authorised officer for the purposes of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*.
