Management report to Council

Debt collection services contract: No 3608

Presenter: Joanne Wandel, Director Property

Purpose and background

- 1. The purpose of this report is to award a tender for the provision of debt collection services for two years, with an option to extend the contract term by up to a further two years, for a maximum total four years.
- 2. Council currently utilises the debt collection services of Collect AU Pty for the recovery of overdue property rates and fire service levy.
- 3. The current contract cost is \$270,000.00, which expired 31 January 2020. The tender was advertised in The Age newspaper on Saturday 7 December 2019. Four tender submissions were received. All tenders were compliant.
- 4. The weightings of the evaluation criteria were declared in the invitation to tender documents, and were Cost (15 per cent), Plan for Proposed Services (35 per cent), Experience, Capability and Past Performance (45 per cent) and Occupational Health and Safety (five per cent).

Key issues

- 5. The ability to instigate legal action is an important collection tool in the recovery of outstanding rates and other debt. The contract award requires the service provider to have the highest level of current local government experience in debt collection.
- 6. The estimated cost of the service is approximately \$274,000.00 (incl. GST) per annum, in line with FY19– 20 budget. The initial term of the contract is two years. Note that approximately 99 per cent of the costs incurred to provide the debt collection services are fully recoverable through income recovery line.
- 7. The preferred tenderer has proven to have the key skills required to carry out all debt collection services in line with council's requirements.

Recommendation from management

8. That Council awards the contract for the provision of Debt Collection Services to Collect AU Pty for a term of two years commencing 1 March 2020 with an option to extend the contract term by up to a further two years in accordance with the schedule of rates and otherwise in accordance with the negotiated terms and conditions of the contract.

Legal

1.
