# **Building Property Enquiry fact sheet**

## What is a Building Property Enquiry?

A Building Property Enquiry is a way of requesting information, prescribed under Regulation 51 of the Building Regulations 2018, from the relevant Council on a particular address within their municipality.



# What type of information is included?

There are three options for the certificates as per the below. Please be mindful that Option 3 is rarely required and can take a significant amount of time to process, this should only be applied for if necessary.

#### **Option 1 – Building Regulations 51(1)**

- Details of Building Permits covering the previous 10 years (not physical copies)
- Details of Occupancy Permits and Certificates of Final Inspection (not physical copies)
- Details of Current Building Notices or Orders (Not physical copies)
- Details of statements issued under Reg 64 or 153

#### **Option 2 - Building Regulations 51(2)**

Information on whether a property is in an area:

- liable to flooding (Reg 153)
- liable to infestation by termites (Reg 150)
- prone to bush fire (Reg 155)
- liable to significant snowfalls (Reg 181)
- liable to overland flooding (Reg 154)

#### **Option 3 - Building Regulations 51(3)**

Contains all of the information included in Option 1. Also provides details of inspection approval dates of the mandatory notification stages for building work carried out on land or buildings.

### How long will a 'Building Property Enquiry' take?

Applications will be processed within five business days and sent electronically via email.

#### Fees

Fees are charged per sub regulation. E.g. Options 1 & 3 would require two application fees to be paid. Fees are statutory in nature. Full fee schedule can be viewed at: https://www.melbourne.vic.gov.au/SiteCollectionDocuments/property-information-schedule-of-fees.pdf

### What you must provide

For Options 1 and 3 you may be required to provide a copy of the certificate of title and title plan/plan of subdivision.
