2. in accordance with a resolution of the Council passed on 26 September 2006:


THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:

- 3. the *Designated sound level* for busking activity is:
 - 3.1. in the area of the municipality shown hatched and within the bold lines on the attached map and known as the Bourke Street Mall, 82 dBA L10, when measured for 1 minute at a distance of 3 metres from the source of sound and 76 dBA L10 when measured for 1 minute at a distance of 6 metres from the source of sound; and
 - 3.2. in the rest of the municipality, 75 dBA L10, when measured for 1 minute at a distance of 3 metres from the source of sound and 69 dBA L10 when measured for 1 minute at a distance of 6 metres from the source of sound¹.
