
## **STREETCOUNT 2018:** A SNAPSHOT OF PEOPLE LIVING ROUGH

Population sizes for reference numbers: <sup>1</sup>(279), <sup>2</sup>(62), <sup>3</sup>(56), <sup>4</sup>(201), <sup>5</sup>(218), <sup>6</sup>(269), <sup>7</sup>(65), <sup>8</sup>(64), <sup>9</sup>(61). <sup>^</sup>This StreetCount was across the entire municipality. This figure relates to comparison between the same StreetCount areas in 2016 and 2018.
